


LIC's population grew by 40% between 2010 and 2021 - 5.7x faster than the growth rate for New York City








New businesses opened in the BID in the past 12 months

Foot traffic on Jackson Avenue increased by 63% in the morning and 78% in the afternoon between Fall 2022 and Fall 2023


